LITERACY



The children will be reading for pleasure the story 'How to Train Your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell.

They will be practising their writing skills across the genres by writing diary entries, setting descriptions, character

MATHEMATICS



The children will continue to develop their maths knowledge and skills.

In particular this term the children will develop their understanding of fractions, looking at identifying fractions as well as finding fractions of a number.

They will also work on how to tell the time accurately.

Science

The children will be investigating the digestive system, comparing animals and humans systems. We will also be investigating teeth and then making comparisons with different animals.

History

The children will be investigating the Vikings and in particular how the Vikings invaded England, the reasons why they did this and how they changed the way people in England lived.

HOW CAN PARENTS HELP?

- Work with your child on their homework. Also continue to practise their spellings each week. Homework will be handed out on Fridays and be collected in on Wednesdays.
- Continue to read with your child, particularly books of their choice and related to class topics.
- Ensure your child has a full PE kit in school all week. Year 4 PE days are Tuesdays and Wednesdays but this can change so we advise that children leave a kit, in a named bag, on their peg all week.
